

## Neuroimmunology and MS Match Guidelines

Neuroimmunology and MS Match	<ul> <li>✓ 1-year predominantly clinical fellowships</li> <li>✓ 2–3-year fellowships combining clinical training with general clinical research training</li> </ul>
The above include programs that are <b>adult only, pediatric only,</b> or <b>combined adult and pediatric</b> .	
<b>Exceptions</b> Handled outside the Match Process	<ul> <li>✓ fellowships that do not include a clinical training component</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>✓ applicants being recruited by an individual PI to work on specific funded clinical, translational, or laboratory research projects</li> </ul>
Any institutions who routinely offer this type of opportunity should identify themselves, including the options for off-Match positions (ex: research fellowship in neurosarcoidosis, research fellowship in myelitis, bench-based work in human immunology). This information will be posted on the ACTRIMS website, available to both applicants and institutions	
Timelines for this type of fellow should be harmonized across institutions and should precede the Match; offers should be made beginning approximately four (4) weeks prior to rank list deadline of April 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2025.
